

25 *Grant by Edward I to Alvingham Priory of free warren in all its demense lands in Alvingham, Cokerington and Kedington, providing that these lands are not within the limits of the king's forest; the penalty for entering these lands to hunt or take anything without the permission of the priory is £10.*
